Recognitions

The Knob Noster High School Wrestling State Qualifiers, School Board Members, and Stealth Panther Robotics were recognized.

Action Items

- The Board approved the FY 2020 Impact Aid Application.
- The Board approved the proposed 2019-2020 School Year Calendar.
- The Board approved the relocation of fifth grade back to the elementary schools beginning summer school 2019.
- The Board approved Knob Noster Clay Target League as a club sport for the 2019 season following a presentation by Mrs. Macae McKinley, Knob Noster Ag Educator and FFA Sponsor.

Notable Discussion / Information Items

- Results from the 2018 APR were provided from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. Knob Noster posted a strong 98.7% APR score.
- The annual School Board Candidate Forum is scheduled for Tuesday, March 12 at 6:00 pm in the Knob Noster Middle School Cafeteria. Candidates on the ballot (in the order they filed) are: Tom Hughes, Larry Bolton, Cliff Everts, and Jared Goucher.
- The district is bidding health insurance for employees again this year. The district expects renewal rates from MEUHP by mid-March.
- The proposed final CSIP was provided as a first reading to the Board.
