Recognitions

Outgoing school board member, Mr. Tom Hughes, was recognized for his years of service on the Knob Noster Board of Education. Mr. Larry Bolton and Mr. Cliff Everts took the oath of office as Knob Noster School Board members for three-year terms.

Action Items

- School Board officers were nominated and elected as follows: Board President, Mrs. Leslie Walling; Board Vice President, Mrs. Kelly Davis; Board Treasurer, Mr. Clint Judd; Board Secretary, Mrs. Dody Millard.
- The Board approved the Snow Make Up Day Plan for the 2018-2019 school year. Students will make up two snow days on April 22 and May 24. May 23 will be a full day of school, and May 24 will be the last day of school for students with a 1:00 early dismissal. Four make up days will be waived for students. Teachers will make up four contract days with Professional Development sessions May 28-31.
- The Board approved the proposal for district health insurance and related services from Bukaty (Blue Cross Blue Shield Kansas City) for the 2019-2020 school year.
- The Board approved policy amendments for Policy GCBDA (Professional Staff Short-Term Leaves) and Policy GBDBA (Support Staff Leave).

Notable Discussion / Information Items

- The district may consider recommending a pilot preschool program at Whiteman Elementary as early as the fall of 2019. The early Kindergarten program would focus on on-base students and would be funded through Impact Aid.
