Recognitions

Knob Noster High School Track & Field athletes who qualified to compete at the State Championship were recognized as Phenomenal Panthers. The Women's Track & Field team were highlighted for taking 3rd Place in Class 3. School community partners, Paul Hills, Peggie Miller, Mona Parrott, Debbie Shivers, and Candi Wagler, were recognized as Partners in Education.

Missouri House Representative (District 52) Bradley Pollitt presented a resolution to the Board from himself and Speaker Haahr commemorating Knob Noster High School's recent recognition by U.S. News and World Report as the Number 1 rural high school in Missouri for 2019.
