**MAP Testing:** Missouri Assessment Program will be coming soon! All students in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade take these mandatory state assessments. Testing will begin Tuesday, April 30<sup>th</sup> and end on Thursday, May 9<sup>th</sup>. Students will test on Tues, Wed and Thurs mornings each week. Please make sure they are on time and we will provide a FREE breakfast both weeks for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> grade students. We will provide snacks after testing. Please also make sure laptops are charged each day and students bring their earbuds or headphones. Thank you for your support!

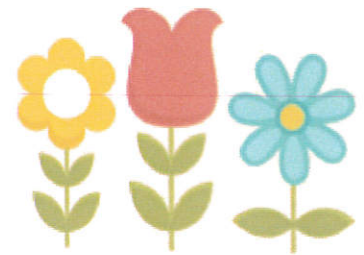

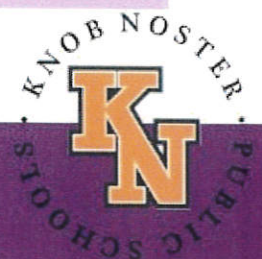
